The detail:

This event is to celebrate our first 10 years of running La Forge <u>http://www.le-plessis-lastelle.com/index.html</u> as a holiday home. It is open to all of our friends, family and select club members of La Forge and will be running from Saturday 2nd July to Sunday 3rd July, with the main event being the party on Saturday night.

We are arranging this to coincide with Le Tour de France <u>http://www.letour.com/le-tour/2016/us/overall-route.html</u> which passes very close to La Forge at La Haye du Puits on Saturday 2nd July 2016 (Mont St Michel to Utah Beach) and again on Sunday 3rd July 2016 (St Lo to Cherbourg).

We are going to set up a camping area in the garden so bring your own tent and sleeping bag. We can take your things across in advance if you are going to be arriving as foot passengers.

We intend to bulk buy the food for a barbecue and all the beer, cider,

wine, cheese and soft drinks in advance. We will be charging a fee for accommodation to cover some of the costs, all rates below shown are per room per night:

Camping £6 per person per night.

On the Saturday we will be driving to and from La Haye du Puits to take you to watch the tour or you can cycle one of the many bikes we have instead. We expect there to be a town festival atmosphere with market stalls selling food and drink.

On the Sunday we will be returning you to the port of Cherbourg where you will be able to see the finish of stage two. From there you will be able to make your way back to the ferry.

We have 14 spaces. However you are more than welcome to bring your own car or camper van as there is ample parking available.

The return ferry is on Sunday 3rd July at 20.15pm. So no school days will be missed.
